Rules

- 1. Beat 1: Root (primary choice) or 5th (use sparingly!)
- 2. Beat 4: A. Leading Tone
B. Chromatic
C. V of next chord
D. M3 or b2 above
- 3. Beats 2&3: Chord or Scale Tone
(if lept to, then chord tone)
(if by step, then scale of chord tone)
- 4. Use counterpoint rules concerning leaps and changes of direction
